QUALIFICATION:-

The Candidate must have secured Minimum 55% marks (aggregate) in last two years/ last 4 semesters in Graduation (i.e. BE/ B Tech. / BSc Engg.) in respective discipline.

For Materials discipline the candidate must have secured Minimum 55 % marks (aggregate) in last two years / last 4 semesters in Graduation (i.e. BE/B Tech. / Bsc Engg.) in Chemical, Mechanical, Electrical or Instrumentation discipline.

Wherever CGPA/ OGPA or letter grade is awarded in a degree, the candidate will have to indicate equivalent percentage marks.

For SC & ST Candidates, the minimum percentage required is relaxed by 5% in all disciplines.

Functional knowledge of computers is desirable.

Candidates who have appeared / are appearing for the final year examination may also apply. However, they will be called for Personal Interview, (if declared successful in the

Written Test) only if their results are declared before the date of Personal Interview. If the result is not available on the date of interview, their candidature shall be cancelled.

AGE AS ON 1.6.2009:-

Not exceeding 30years for SC & ST Candidates

Not exceeding 28years for OBC Candidates

Company's employees are eligible for relaxation in age by five years.

The age limit is relaxable by 5 years for candidates domiciled in Jammu and Kashmir between 1.1.1980 to 31.12.1989, 5 years for Ex-servicemen, and 5 years for Children/family members of the victims of 1984 riots.

Selection, Training and Placement:-

The selection methodology will comprise – Written Test – (consisting of General Aptitude and Academic knowledge) and Personal Interview for assessment of different facets of Knowledge, Skills, Attitude and Aptitude. Candidates will have to pass through each stage successfully before being adjudged as suitable for selection.

Candidates can exercise the option of appearing in the selection process in Hindi or English.

Candidates applying for Material Management Discipline shall appear for written test in their respective branch of Engineering.

Selected candidates will be undergoing training for one year and will be offered a lump sum stipend of Rs.17, 500/- per month. Free lodging and boarding facility will also be provided at Company's Hostel. Candidates not availing this facility shall be paid Rs.1000/- p.m. as Transportation allowance.

After successful completion of training they will be absorbed in the scale of pay of Rs.16400-40500/- (revised). Total monthly gross emoluments at the minimum of the Basic Pay inclusive of Dearness Allowance, HRA and other allowances works out to around Rs. 32,000/-. Other benefits as per company rules which include Medical Facilities, Gratuity, Contributory Provident Fund, Employees Pension Scheme, Group Savings Linked Scheme, Accident Insurance, Leave Encashment, House Building Loan Interest Subsidy, etc. shall also be applicable.

SERVICE BOND:-

Selected candidates will have to execute a bond of Rs.75,000 to complete the training and to serve the Company for a minimum period of three years after completion of training.
