# **SCOPE OF WORK**

Scope of work for need based manpower supply with required/listed materia I for various maintenance jobs in plant sections of Ammonia Plant.

#### A. INSTRUCTIONS RELATED TO MANPOWER:

A-1. The requirement of manpower with supply of materials is for GV, Reforme

- r, compressor house, etc. section related electrical jobs in shutdown of Am monia Plant-Electrical department is **need based and not of continuous nature**.
- A-2. Manpower (skilled technician and unskilled helper) is required for shutdow n. The scope of work for manpower covers, but not limited to, provision of t emporary connection, cable laying, terminations, etc.at various sections of plant.
- A-3. Manpower shall be made available, as and when required, for jobs in shift slots comprising of Morning (0600-1400Hrs), Evening (1400-2200Hrs.), Nig ht(2200-0600Hrs.). Requirement of manpower may be on continuous/round the clock basis, at any time of day, on any day (including Sundays and holi days).
- A-4. Round the clock working, within defined time slots, may be required. Bidd er to ensure required manpower will be available in all the shifts. Adequate manpower shall be arranged by the contractor without break in services in cluding Sundays and Holidays. Manpower shall not leave the site without c ompletion of duty/information to Engineer In-Charge.
- A-5. Technicians shall be qualified electricians. They shall be technically experienced persons.
- A-6. Job may involve connections at platforms on height greater than 5 meters . Personnel shall be fit for height job. RCF may conduct height-pass test for the personnel. If found unfit in height-pass test, bidder shall replace the personnel with suitable/fit personnel.
- A-7. Timely supply of skilled & unskilled manpower with listed material is the e ssence of contract.
- A-8. The technician and helper shall be available at site at all the times. They will be stationed at job site and shall co-ordinate with RCF job in-charge for connection requirements.
- A-9. Site-Technician shall be available on site with a mobile phone, on round t he clock basis i.e. in every shift. For any job in plant section technician will be contacted on phone. Technician shall make sure that all the connection asked for during his shift are given on time. One of technician may be accounted for over all control and coordination of contractor's manpower with R CF personnel.
- A-10. Plant Sections nearby may be clubbed together and technician+helper sh all be accounted/allocated for the same clubbing.
- A-11. All the required temporary connections (irrespective of material either provided by contractor or by RCF) in the allocated sections shall be done by technicians/helpers
- A-12. Manpower shall be made available within shortest possible time on intima tion.4-5 days' intimation will be given in advance.
- A-13. The rates shall be same for all time of day (round the clock basis), at any day (including holidays) and after normal duty hours.
- A-14. Transportation of equipment (contractor's or RCF's material) to site will be e in contractor's scope.
- A-15. As requirement is need based, quantum of work is not guaranteed. Payme nt shall be made on actual job carried out.
- A-16. The contractor must make available following safety appliances to manpo wer while at site: Safety Helmet, Safety shoes, Ear plugs, Hand gloves, etc. Apart from these any other job specific PPE, if required, shall be provided by RCF. Safety training from RCF's safety department must be taken by all persons before starting the job.
- A-17. The contractor must make available following basic tools and tackles to m

anpower while at site: Combination plier, wire stripper, suitable screw drive rs, electrical tester, etc. Apart from these any other job specific tools, if req uired, shall be provided by RCF.

- A-18. The manpower supplied shall be medically fit for job in Ammonia Plant. Ne cessary medical examination shall be carried out at RCF OHC before comm encement of job. If any personnel are found unfit for the job, same shall be replaced by the contractor in shortest possible time.
- A-19. Minimum Requirement of manpower/mobilization will be as follows:

Additional manpower if required shall be intimated 1 days in advance by RCF.

A-20. Two mobilizations per year are envisaged.

# B. <u>INSTRUCTIONS RELATED TO MATERIAL:</u>

The scope covers, but is not limited to, supply (on returnable basis) and connection (as-and when required) of following readily available and tested material:

# B-1.

Any additional quantity of material mentioned above, if required, shall be made available by contactor in shortest possible time. RCF will intimate contractor 1 days in advance for additional material.

- B-2. All the material shall be as per relevant IEC/IS standards, best engineerin g practices and CEA standards. Material shall be suitably enclosed for use in industries.
- B-3. Earthing connections shall be made as per relevant IS.
- B-4. Suitable distribution board (DB) will be provided by RCF. A suitable single point supply to DB shall be given by RCF. Connection of RCF's supply to DB will be contractor's scope.
- B-5. Distribution and connection of contractor's material from DB shall be in c ontractor's scope. All the required suitable cables, plugs, sockets, etc. for c onnection of material shall be in party's scope.
- B-6. Contractor shall mark his material in such a way that contractor's materia I shall be distinguishable from RCF's material. All the material (light fittings, boards, etc.) shall be in pre-connected with suitable cables, plugs, etc. and ready to use state. Assembly of contractor's material (wiring of boards, fittings, other material) at RCF premises shall be avoided.
- B-7. Contractor shall be responsible for his material. RCF will not be accounte d for any loss/damage to contractor's material.
- B-8. During execution, if any of the contactor's material is found out-of-order, then contactor shall replace it within shortest possible time.
- B-9. Any call for connection /termination of material shall be addressed promp tly by the technician.
- B-10. Proper housekeeping and removal/return of material shall be done after c ompletion of job.
- B-11. Any other temporary material connection not specified, but felt necessary for job, shall be done by contactor. Such special material shall be provided by RCF. Connection of such material shall be done by contactor's personnel

## C. Additional Clauses for Manpower supply and material supply.

C-1. The contractor shall be solely responsible for any damages to the machinery,

equipment and property of RCF due to negligence of his staff or defective tool s and tackles while installation & commissioning job.

- C-2. The Contractor will be responsible for the insurance of his supervisory, skilled and u nskilled staff under the workmen's compensation Act 1923, 1933 and subsequent a mendment if any, thereon. The Contractor should produce copies of insurance of his staff for verification.
- C-3. Owner reserves the right to reject any of his persons employed by the Contractor fo r incompetence or misbehavior. The Contractor shall replace such persons immediat ely by suitable one. Contractor's staff shall not be withdrawn by the Contractor from site without the prior permission of RCF In-charge.
- C-4. No person other than the Contractor's workforce shall be allowed to work at the site in connection with works, except with special permission in writing of Engineer in charge.
- C-5. The Owner/RCF assumes no responsibility for any damages due to accidents or any other cause to the erection of equipment or persons employed by the Contractor.
- C-6. The Contractor will ensure that all time the persons appointed by him is company's premises are physically fit and are free from any disease, illness, contagious or other wise in order to ensure that a healthy, hygienic and clear services are maintained.
- C-7. The Contractor shall ensure that the person or person appointed by them for service in the company's premises do not suffer any legal disqualification for service by reas on of his age or any law and statute in force from time to time of any other reason w hatsoever.
  - C-8. The employee of the contractor shall be liable to search by company's securit y forces.
- C-9. If the Engineer-In-Charge is not satisfied with the service or conduct of any of the employee of the contractor for any reason whatsoever, the contractor shall remove such employees from the company's premises.
  - C-10. No. employee of the contractor shall be allowed to stay on the premises of the company beyond authorized working hours.
  - C-11. Contractor shall obtain all licenses / permits required for the employment of labour at site under relevant laws and shall maintain all such registers/record s as required by such laws in force and display such information and notices as are required. Any information required by RCF for discharge of obligations under such laws shall be promptly furnished by the contractor to RCF. The co ntractor shall quote his PF number and registration under contract labour law regulations without which his quotation may not be considered. All staff empl oved by the contractor shall be the Contractor's employee for all intents and purposes. The workers will be deployed at RCF site as per the requirement of the job only. After expiry/termination of the contract, the contractor shall tak e out all his employees from RCF Site. RCF shall not take any responsibility re garding employment of Contractor's employees. If any of the employees clai m employment in RCF contractor's Security deposit shall be forfeited. This co ntract shall be governed by the laws of Union of India for the time being in for ce. The contractor shall comply with all Central, State and Municipal laws and Rules and legislation, laws pertaining to payment of minimum wages etc. in f orce from time to time and shall be solely responsible to comply with all oblig ations and payments thereunder.

- C-12. No compensation will be entertained for the liabilities arising out of any provisions of any Act, Laws, Rules and legislation, in force from time to time. In case RCF has to pay any charges for non-compliance of any Act, Enactment, laws, Rules and Legislation in force from time to time by the contractor, the same shall be recovered from the contractor.
- C-13. The contractor shall submit all the relevant documents showing compliance of all the relevant Acts, Laws, Rules and Legislation as and when called by RC F.
- C-14. Contractor shall have to observe all the safety practices as required and shall provide safety wear for his workmen. Contractor and his employees should observe all safety regulations within factory area as directed by owner's safety department from time to time.
- C-15. Technicians appointed must be having experience and qualification for the j ob to be carried by the contractor.
- C-16. Workman's experience, age, address, character and medical fitness certificate need to be certified by the contractor before starting the job.
- C-17. All persons must take safety training from safety dept. of RCF before starting the job.
- C-18. Contractor shall clean up the area after completion of his work by removing all unused material, etc. Contractor shall remove and shall not permit debris to accumulate except in area earmarked for this purpose.
- C-19. Contractor should prepare challans for incoming materials including all in tri plicate and would get them endorsed at material gate of RCF. One copy of all such challans would be retained by the Security department (C.I.S.F.). Other copy should be deposited with respected Engineer in charge to facilitate the return of materials after the completion of job.
- C-20 Bidder to note that supply of required material is an integral part of contract. Only man-power may be used at discretion of RCF. But if on request of RCF, bi dder fails to provide required material then no mobilization and manpower rat es shall be paid off to the bidder.
- **Mobilization:** Mobilization includes supply of minimum manpower and provis ion of minimum material as mentioned in A19 and B1 respectively. Requiremen t of Extra quantity (of manpower/material) within 15 days of original request will be counted in same mobilization as that of original request.

## **E.** <u>Validity of Contract:</u>

Contract shall be valid for one year starting from date of award.

- b) Payment shall be made on actual job carried out.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
