1. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents.

2. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific Scope Of Work(SOW)

Text Clause(s)

SCOPE OF WORK

- 1) The Man power of Skilled Electricians and un-skilled labours are required during the shutdown, breakdowns or as & when required basis. The manpower shall be required in all shifts including Sundays and Holidays. The job includes providing temporary connections, cable laying, cable terminations, Light fitting provisions etc at all locations of the plant and assisting in maintenance of motors, switchboards etc

- . Electrician shall have required tools with them for carrying out the jobs.
- 2) During shut down /breakdown party has to mobilise man power in short notice as per requirement given by RCF Engineer. The shutdown / breakdown period may be two or more times in a year for one week or up to one month duration in various plants in a year.
 - 3) All electricians shall be technically experienced person with relevant certificate of education related to Electrical field. The contractor shall employ only qualified worker on all the jobs.
 - 4) Adequate manpower shall be arranged by the contractor without break in services i.e. including SUNDAY & HOLIDAY. Electrician should not leave the site without completion of the duty.
 - 5) Payment will be made as per actual quantity executed.
 - 6) Actual date of requirement of man power will be intimated 4-7 days in advance.
 - 7) Medical help provided at site shall be limited to First Aid only.
 - 8) Party shall submit the invoice in three copies plant wise.
 - 9) The contractor shall arrange tools like plier, screw driver, tester etc.
 - 10) Contractor has to give minimum wages payment to the engaged manpower as per declared by government. The contractor has to make salary of workers up to 7th day of next month. The contractor shall deposit monthly P. F. contributions and ESIC contributions, within 15 days of the end of every calendar month. The contractor shall submit the list of such employees along with documents as per GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS SECTION-II of NIT for HR clearance purpose.
 - 11) The bills of the contractor will be certified and passed for payment only after production HR clearance NOC.
 - 12) Following are the current payment of revised minimum wages w.e.f. 01.07.2024 declared by state Govt.**
 - i. Skilled: Rs.843.42/- per day (Basic + DA)**
 - ii. Un-Skilled: - Rs.743.61/- per day (Basic + DA)****During quote, bidder shall consider the above minimum wages payment + PF@13% + ESIC@3.25% + BONUS @8.33% of Basic &DA.**
 - 13) Also note that every six months there will be revision of minimum wages, that cost shall be bear by bidders itself. Bidder shall pay the revised payment to the workers at every time.
 - 14) The contractor has to make salary of workers up to 7th day of next month.
 - 15) If the work involves employing **more than 19 (Nineteen)** contract workers, the Bidder should obtain a license from competent authority as per provisions of The Contract labour (Regulations and Abolition) Act, 1970. This License charges shall be in the bidder scope and bidder shall consider the same during quote.

NOTE:

- 1. If total of the charges quoted by any bidder for skilled/unskilled manpower are lesser than sum of the charges as per minimum wages (declared by the State Government) & statutory contribution like PF, ESIC/Insurance, Bonus then that particular bidder offer will be disqualified for the further evaluation.**

- 2. The L1 Bidder shall be decided on the basis of quoted total value.**
- 3. The contract will be split-up between two contractors at same rate s, terms & conditions. The Contract value shall be distributed between L1 & L2 party with the ratio of 55:45.**
- 4. Rates agreed by L1 bidder shall be offered to L2 for matching with L1 bidder. In case L2 bidder does not agree to match their rates with L1 bidder then rates shall be offered to L3, L4 and so on. In case none of the bidder accepts the L1 rates, contract shall be awarded for 100% contract value to L1 bidder.**

TENURE OF CONTRACT - The tenure of the contract shall be for One year.

Disclaimer/अस्वीकरण

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

This Bid is governed by the [General Terms and Conditions/सामान्य नियम और शर्तें](#), conditions stipulated in Bid and [Service Level Agreement](#) specific to this Service as provided in the Marketplace. However in case if any condition specified in General Terms and Conditions/सामान्य नियम और शर्तें is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement, then it will over ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
